A BRIEF HISTORY OF ETVC

ETVC began in 1982 when a small group of friends formed the Educational TV Channel to end the isolation that most transgender people were experiencing in those days. To this end they decided that all major gatherings would be held in public venues, a radical idea for the time

Success was immediate and growth came rapidly. By 1989, when ETVC incorporated, we had grown to more than 400 members. In early 1994 ETVC became a 501 c(3) nonprofit organization under both federal and state laws. ETVC was also a major proponent of the transgender civil rights ordinance enacted in late 1994 by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors.

ETVC is open to all without regard to gender identity, sexual orientation, age, race, creed or disability. Its primary purpose is public education and support for the Bay Area transgender community. It maintains an extensive array of services including monthly education seminars, book, video and audio cassette libraries, the internationally renowned ETVC newsletter, a public speakers bureau, a hotline and voice mail system, computer bulletin board system, an anti-defamation program and monthly social events.

An all-volunteer organization, ETVC is supported by over 500 members and friends, including many of the businesses who advertise in this program.
